It was established in 1978 with it's headquarter in Department of Geography, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi. The main aim of the association is (i) to foster geographical research in the country, (ii) to cooperate with professional organizations of cognate disciplines and to promote academic interaction within an interdisciplinary frame, (iii) to cooperate with international organizations with similar objectives, (iv) to hold an Indian Geography Congress every year in different universities of India. Apart from Indian Geography Congress, the Association also organized International Geography Congress and (v) generally to take all such measures as may help to secure for geography its legitimate place in national life and to strengthen among geographers a sense of national responsibilities and professional efficiency.

The journal provides a medium for wide dissemination of original papers discussing various implications connected with geography from many points of view including international, political, environment, economic, social, medical, managerial, planning, scientific and engineering aspects.
